

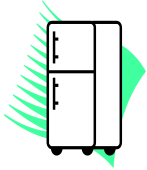

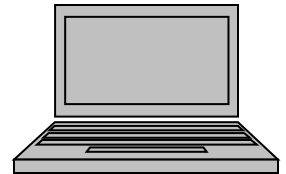

ROSHOLT FOOD PANTRY

FRIENDLY REMINDERS FROM THE ROSHOLT FIRE DISTRICT

We are finishing the first round of the business fire inspections and we would like to thank everyone for their cooperation. The second inspections will start in September.

Please make sure your **driveways are clear of obstructions to allow easy access for all emergency response vehicles.**

DOG LICENSING

Please remember that all dog licenses expire on December 31 of each year. Your dog is not licensed for the current year until you apply for it. State Laws and Portage County Ordinance require that all dogs are to be vaccinated and licensed. Please remember that **all dogs residing in the Town of Sharon must be licensed.**



You may license your dog via mail or at the Town Hall office. A spayed or neutered dog is \$8.00 and dogs that are not spayed or neutered cost \$18.00 per year.

If you no longer have a dog that was licensed previously, please call the town office (if you haven't already) so I can remove the information from our data system. 715-592-6600

LANDLORDS AND NEIGHBORS

When a dog is NOT in their own yard, the dog should be on a leash.

If you know of any dog in the township that is NOT currently (2018) licensed or you are unsure, call us to find out if they are licensed.

If they are not, we can follow through with them getting licensed. YOU WILL REMAIN ANONYMOUS.

Did you ever wonder where your Town of Sharon Real Estate and Personal Property Tax money goes? Me too...so I broke down the tax dollars collected for 2017 based on what we supplied to the Wisconsin Department of Revenue.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHEN DO I NEED A BURNING PERMIT?

Burning permits are required until the ground is completely snow covered. Burning permits are free and easy to obtain. Call 1-888-WISBURN or get your annual permit at: www.dnr.wi.gov/wisburn. The permit is valid for the current calendar year and need to be obtained each year.

ARE ATV'S/UTV'S ALLOWED ON TOWN ROADS?

The Town of Sharon does not have ATV/UTV trails within our boundaries.

WHY DOES THE TOWN HAVE WEIGHT LIMIT PERMITS?

Towns use seasonal or special weight limits depending on the situation. Seasonal weight limits may be imposed during the spring thaw. This protects our Town roads because the road beds are weak due to excess moisture. A weaker road means the pavement is more easily damaged. If anyone wants to exceed a special or seasonal weight limit must first obtain a permit from the town. The Town can then attach conditions to the permit in an effort to protect our Town roads. A few Town roads have year around weight limit restrictions, this can occur due to the road being rebuilt or reconstructed and can be damaged more easily. The effort to extend the life of a road is in process.

WHEN IS A DRIVEWAY PERMIT NEEDED?

Driveway permits are the first step in considering a second driveway or new structure off a Town Road (contact Portage County if you are on a County Road). The permit form will help determine the need for a fire number or culvert and assure the placement of the driveway meets the spacing requirements. Please contact the Town Hall when considering a first or second driveway.

What are you doing in the evening on the Second Tuesday of each month? If your looking for something to do—why not join us at your Town Board meeting . We welcome you Mark your calendar.
