Unsecured Loads

An unsecured load has not been fastened in or attached to the vehicle with tarps, ropes, ratchet straps, netting, or chains, and is likely to fall off the load or the covering from becoming loose, detached, or leaving the vehicle while the vehicle is moving. Unsecured loads may be refused or subject to a surcharge.

Yard Waste

Yard waste or woody debris less than 6 inches in diameter is not accepted. Check with your local municipality for disposal options. Invasive species such as garlic mustard, Japanese knotweed, or buckthorn are accepted if they are bagged.

Latex Paint



These items are not hazardous, but they must be solid before throwing away. Fill a half empty can with OilDri or cat litter. Mix COMPLETELY and leave lid off. It should look like lumpy oatmeal. When paint is solid (2-4 days) throw it in the trash, keeping the lid off.

Latex paint may also be properly disposed of at the Transfer Facility for \$1.50/lbs. March through November, by appointment only. Call 715-346-1931.

Document Shredding



Secure document shredding is available at the Portage County Solid Waste. A limit of three bank sized boxes may be

brought at one time. There is a \$5 per box fee.

Proper Sharps Disposal

Used needles, lancets, and other sharps, must be disposed of separately from regular trash or recyclables. **Do not put sharps or sharps containers in your recycling or trash container.** This program is not intended for businesses such as nursing homes, clinics, hospitals, assisted living homes, treatment centers, or for veterinary care.



Medication Disposal

Properly dispose of unwanted medication at the Plover or Stevens Point Police Stations during normal business hours. Put medication in sealed plastic bag.

Never flush unwanted medication down the drain!

Sharps from residential homes may be brought to one of the following locations for proper disposal:

- Metro Market Pharmacies in Stevens Point & Plover
- Hometown Pharmacies in Stevens Point & Plover
- Trigs Pharmacy in Stevens Point
- Portage County Solid Waste in Plover

Household Hazardous Waste

Rid your home of hazardous materials such as pesticides, herbicides, cleaners, paints, chemicals, gas, and aerosols. The Hazardous Waste Collection program runs March through November by appointment only. Call 715-346-1931. Fees apply. Very small quantity generators, businesses and farms may inquire about their disposal options by calling 715-346-1931.
